- 12 memorial services were held at Kendal. Attendance ranged from 48 to 232 people 1 service was held at First Church, with transportation provided
- 9 families either wished to have no service or held one in their own location away from Kendal

Social Services, Facilities, Dining, the Front Desk, and Administration all cooperate to help provide this service to families wishing to honor and remember those members of our community who have died. Last year, under Ardith Hayes's watch, many organizing protocols were worked out for planning, managing, and ushering. These lists and directives make our job easy.

Helping families honor their loved ones is a blessing. We often get requests for unusual seating arrangements. The smallest memorial service this year was in the Education Building and the largest completely filled both the Auditorium and Lounge. We have been able to accommodate several unusual requests because of the help and cooperation of residents with special talents.
